### Programme

Università Cattolica, through the Faculty of Banking, Finance and Insurance Sciences, Master's Degree Programs (Laurea Magistrale) in Banking and Finance and Economics of Markets and of Financial Intermediaries, offers its students the possibility of obtaining a double qualification at the conclusion of their study path:

- Laurea Magistrale in Banking and Finance, Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore
- Diploma in Accounting and Finance, London School of Economics

### When



The mobility will take place throughout the first year of the Laurea Magistrale in Banking and Finance. Departures are scheduled in September 2021 for the 2021/2022 academic year.

### How to apply

Students enrolled in the third year of a Laurea Triennale (at Università Cattolica or in other Institutions, but interested in applying for the academic year 2021/22 for the Laurea Magistrale in banking and Finance in Università Cattolica) can apply for the program by completing 2 different steps:

- Registering through UCSC with a non-refundable 35€ application fee by March 1, 2021
- [Application to LSE](#) by March 1, 2021. Applications are due by March 1st, 2021. Final admission decisions for this pro-

gram will be the sole responsibility of LSE and will be confirmed to each applicant about 1 month after the application is submitted.

Students admitted to the Diploma Program at LSE must:

- Apply to the Laurea Magistrale in Banking and Finance in Università Cattolica according to the deadlines and the admission rules set by the department;
- Obtain their first level degree (Laurea Triennale) by September 2021, before their departure for London and be officially enrolled at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore during their time at LSE (keeping to university set deadlines for fees, study plans, graduation scheduling requests etc).

### Cost



Selected students will be responsible for the costs of their stay abroad (travel, room and board, LSE registration fees, costs of academic material, health insurance and visa issuance fees).

### Student Safety Package



All students participating in an official Cattolica International program must accept the "[Student Safety Package](#)" provisions by downloading the "Safety Check Students" app for the geo-location and instant messaging features to be used exclusively in the event of an emergency. The "Student Safety Package" also includes health insurance coverage for the entire duration of the program.
